Note: If an individual has already won 1st place at another fair in 2011 for this Blue Ribbon Apple Pie contest, that individual is now considered qualified through that Fair to compete at the 2012 PA Farm Show and is no longer eligible to enter this contest at any upcoming Fairs.

Each pie is judged on the following basis:

Flavor	30 points
Crust: color, flavor, texture, doneness	20 points
Filling: consistency, doneness, moistness, flavor	25 points
Overall appearance	15 points
Creativity	10 points

Rules:

1. Creativity is essential to a varied competition. Do not limit your pie to a “traditional” two-crust apple pie.
2. No milk or eggs in the recipe accepted. Variations in the filling are encouraged.
3. **Recipe must accompany pie. Printed on an 8 ½”x11” piece of paper, one side only, with name, address, and phone number on the back.** This recipe will also need to be submitted when entering at the PA Farm Show.
4. Pie must include at least 60% apples in the filling.
5. Refrigeration is NOT available at the Fair or PA Farm Show. Entries that require refrigeration after baking must indicate so in the recipe. Those entries will not be sold, auctioned or otherwise distributed for consumption after judging for food safety reasons.
6. Each fair certifies the winning apple pie baker who must enter their pie in the **2012 PA Farm Show** competition representing the South Mountain Fair Association.

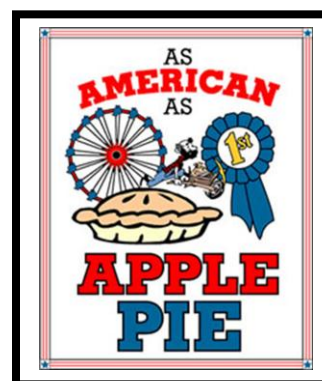

2. Recipe must include at least one cup or more of the following PA grown vegetables: asparagus, beans, beets, broccoli, cabbage, carrots, cauliflower, celery, cucumber, greens, eggplant, garlic, horseradish, leeks, onion, parsley, peas, pepper, pumpkin, spinach, summer squash, zucchini, sweet corn, sweet potatoes, tomatoes, turnips or winter squash.
3. **Recipe must accompany the entry.**
4. Judging criteria:

• Overall appearance	30 points
• Inside characteristics (texture and doneness)	35 points
• Flavor	25 points
• Creativity	10 points

ANGEL FOOD CAKE CONTEST

Open to Pennsylvania residents only.

Rules:

1. Entry must be an Angel Food cake made from scratch.
2. If an individual has already won 1st place at another fair in 2011 for this Angel Food cake contest, that individual is now considered qualified through that Fair to compete at the 2012 PA Farm Show and is no longer eligible to enter this contest at any upcoming Fairs.
3. Pennsylvania produced and packed eggs are requested to be used if at all possible. Please look for the PEQAP or PA Preferred logo or PA packaging dates on the carton.
4. Cake must be submitted for judging on cardboard (no doily required).
5. **Recipe(s) listing the ingredients and the preparation instructions must be submitted on one side of an 8 ½"x11" paper, and entrant's name, address, and phone number must be printed on the back of the page.**
6. Cake may be iced or filled.
7. Refrigeration is NOT available at the Fair or PA Farm Show. Entries that require refrigeration after baking must indicate so in the recipe. Those entries will not be sold, auctioned or otherwise distributed for consumption after judging for food safety reasons.

HERSHEY'S COCOA CLASSIC CHOCOLATE CAKE BAKING CONTEST

Open to Pennsylvania residents only.

Pennsylvania State Association of County Fairs

Rules:

1. One entry per person.
2. If an individual has already won 1st place at another fair in 2011 for this Hershey's Cocoa cake contest, that individual is now considered qualified through that Fair to compete at the 2012 PA Farm Show and is no longer eligible to enter this contest at any upcoming Fairs.
3. Entry must be a layered chocolate cake made from "scratch" and frosted (no mixes).
4. *CAKE RECIPE*: A minimum of ¼ cup of HERSHEY'S COCOA must be used and listed as "HERSHEY'S COCOA" in the cake batter part of the recipe.
5. *FROSTING/ DRIZZLE*: If chocolate frosting or chocolate drizzle is used, HERSHEY'S COCOA must be used and listed as "HERSHEY'S COCOA" in the frosting/drizzle parts of the recipe.
6. If candy, chocolate, or flavored baking chips are used, they must be HERSHEY'S, REESE'S, or HEATH brand products, and listed with their brand name in the recipe. (See www.hersheys.com for complete product list.)
7. The entire cake entry must be submitted for judging on cardboard or a disposable plate. Recipe must be submitted and must list all ingredients, quantities, and the preparation instructions on an 8 ½"x11" paper. Entrant's name, address and phone number must be printed on the back side of all the pages.
8. Refrigeration is not available at the Fair. Entries that require refrigeration after baking must indicate so in the recipe. Those entries will not be sold or auctioned or otherwise distributed for consumption after judging for food safety reasons.
9. Judging criteria:
 - Flavor (aroma, taste, good balance of flavorings) 30 points
 - Texture (moist and tender crumb, not soggy or dry) 25 points
 - Inside Characteristics (even grain, evenly baked) 20 points
 - Outside Characteristics (size and shape; overall appeal) 15 points
 - Frosting (taste, texture, even color) 10 points

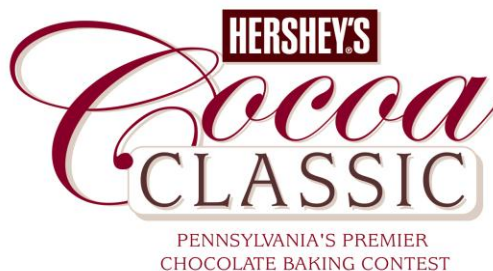

Rules:

1. Exhibitor must be an individual (age 8 through and including 18 years ONLY). One entry per person.
2. If an individual has already won 1st place at another fair in 2011 for this Hershey's Cookie, Brownie or Bar contest, that individual is now considered qualified through that Fair to compete at the 2012 PA Farm Show and is no longer eligible to enter this contest at any upcoming Fairs.
3. Entry must be a plate of six (6) cookies, brownies or bars made from "scratch" (no mixes).
4. A minimum of ½ cup of HERSHEY'S BAKING CHIPS (any variety) must be used and listed as "HERSHEY'S" and name the specific chip variety in the cookie/brownie/bar batter part of recipe.
5. If chocolate frosting or chocolate drizzle is used, HERSHEY'S COCOA must be used and listed as "HERSHEY'S COCOA" in the frosting/drizzle part of the recipe.

9. **Recipe(s) must be submitted with the entry, printed on one side of an 8 ½"x11" paper. Recipe must list all ingredients, quantities, and the preparation instructions. Entrant's name, address and phone number must be printed on the back side of all the pages.**
10. Refrigeration is not available at the Fair. Entries that require refrigeration after baking must indicate so in the recipe. Those entries will not be sold or auctioned or otherwise distributed for consumption after judging for food safety reasons.

Judging criteria:

- Flavor (aroma, taste, good balance of flavorings) 30 points
- Texture (appropriate for the type of cookie, brownie or bar) 25 points
- Inside Characteristics (even grain, evenly baked) 20 points
- Outside Characteristics (size, shape, appearance) 15 points
- Creativity 10 points

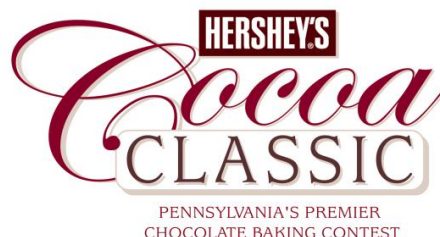
