General Rules:

See General Fair Rules and Regulations.

1. Exhibits may not have been entered previously at the Fair.
2. All pictures must be framed, dry, and **properly wired for hanging**, and include owner's name and dated. Senior Section: No string with masking tape will be accepted as suitable hangers.
3. All exhibits must be original.
4. Paintings and crafts must have been completed by exhibitor.
5. All entries must be completed within the last 2 years. Old entries may be shown, but will not be judged.
6. Pictures and crafts will be limited to one per exhibitor per class.
7. The committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.
8. When classes are not filled, prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the committee and judge.
9. The public is asked to refrain from handling any exhibit. An individual damaging any exhibit will be responsible to the exhibitor.
10. Elementary and Junior Sections are open to anyone ages 17 and under. The Senior/Adult Sections are open to anyone ages 18 and over. A professional is anyone who in the last year, has taken commissions and/or earned money for their art, craft, or photography, other than prize money.
11. Honorable mention awards may be awarded at the judge's discretion (ribbons only) for Junior Sections only.
12. This department is not responsible for any damage which may be incurred.
13. Exhibits will be accepted on Sunday, August 19, 2012 from 2-4 p.m. and on Monday, August 20, 2012 from 4-8 p.m. or the General Entries Registration Form may be used if mailed by August 1. The General Entries form can be found at the back of this book or on the web site at www.southmountainfair.com.
14. Professional artists are not eligible to enter any classes except the Professional Artist Portfolio class.
15. Professional Portfolio exhibitors must submit 4 framed paintings, **properly wired for hanging**, from any of the classes, one per class. A professional is defined as anyone owning/operating a studio and/or earning whole/part of their income from painting.
16. Exhibits will be released to exhibitors on Sunday, August 26, 2012 from 2-4 p.m. No prize money will be awarded for exhibits removed in violation of this rule.
