Health and General Rules:

See General Livestock information.

1. Exhibitor must reside in Pennsylvania.
2. All health certificates must be checked upon arrival and before animals are unloaded.
3. No goats showing clinical signs of contagious or infectious, or external parasitic disease, including foot rot and sore mouth, will be admitted to any show.
4. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI), **issued after May 1**, is required.
5. Individual official animal identification is required. Official ID includes: a scrapie eartag, an ISO-compliant RFID tag, or a scrapie tattoo. Goats with an official scrapie tattoo must also have a unique individual animal ID (tattoo) to meet the scrapie ID requirements or goats having a breed registration tattoo and accompanied by a registration certificate are exempt from the scrapie ID requirement if the tattoo is legible and a registration certificate or a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection which lists the tattoo and registry accompanies the animal at all times since birth.
6. An Animal Owner or Caretaker's Verification of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship (VCPR) form must accompany each animal and must be presented upon arrival at the Fair.
7. Space is limited. Entries will be accepted on a first-come first-serve basis. In the event that space for all entries is not possible, each exhibitor may be limited to 6 head. Health papers need to accompany animals.
8. No equipment, feed, hay, bedding, etc. will be allowed to be stored in pens in the barns. These items must be kept in trailers.
9. Judges reserve the right to rearrange the classes according to number of entries.
10. **No market animal may be dual entered as a breeding animal for any species.**
11. No more than two goats per exhibitor per class will be accepted.
12. **The Goat Entry Form can be found at the back of this book or on the Premium Book page on the web site at www.southmountainfair.com and must be returned to the Department 6 chairperson.**

Section 1 – Registered Boer (Must be registered 88% or higher-Must show registration papers)

Section 2 – Boer Crossbred (Boer crossed with any breed-need not be registered)

Section 3 – Other (Dairy, Pygmy, Nigerian Dwarf, Fainting, etc.-need not be registered)

Section 4 – Fiber Breeds (Any fiber breed or crossbred-need not be registered)
