- 1. Attended Grand History Tour meeting at Frederick County Planning. This involves an effort by Rails to Trails and others to establish a trail system that would generally form a loop between the Washington, D.C. area, York County PA, Gettysburg, PA, south to Frederick, and back to D.C. Efforts currently are focused on more populated areas, but Emmitsburg is in the loop.
